Tasting : The color is ruby, dark.
After aeration woody notes, grilled, black fruits.
On the palate nice attack very silky, well balanced;
sweetness, roundness. Black fruits, sour cherry.
Woody melted notes, well integrated with the fruit.
Long finish on soft tannins.

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
